





# BACK PANEL / BOTTOM PANEL REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS



## BACK PANEL REMOVAL / INSTALLATION

**TOOLS NEEDED:**




### Back Panel Removal:

- A) Remove screws and washers that secure back panel to frame assembly, using a 7/16" wrench.
- B) Lift and pull back panel out and away from frame assembly.

### Back Panel Installation:


- A) Lift and place back panel onto frame assembly.
- B) Install screws and washers to secure back panel to frame assembly, using a 7/16" wrench.

## GREASE TRAY / DRIP PAN REMOVAL

- A) **For Grill Stability:** Replace the two top screws from the rear panel into the top support bar on the cabinet assembly.
- B) **If your grill has an LP Cylinder:** Disconnect propane tank and remove from cabinet (not pictured).
- C) Remove the grease tray and catch-pan from the cabinet of the grill.
- D) Remove any additional components from inside of the cabinet.




## BOTTOM PANEL REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

### TOOLS NEEDED:




#### Catch-Pan Holder Removal:

- A) Remove the three (3) screws that secure the catch-pan holder to the grill assembly.
- B) Remove the catch-pan holder.




#### Bottom Panel Removal:


- A) Remove the bolts and washers from both sides holding on the bottom panel to the grill assembly. (Use a 7/16" wrench)



- B) Pull the bottom panel out by lifting one side up and tilting bottom panel up and out of the cabinet assembly.



**INSTALL NEW BOTTOM PANEL,  
THEN FOLLOW THIS REPLACEMENT SHEET  
IN REVERSE ORDER FOR GRILL RE-ASSEMBLY.**



**⚠ RE-ASSEMBLY NOTE: THE SIX SUPPLIED "J-HOOKS" MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE NEW BOTTOM PANEL BEFORE PANEL IS INSTALLED.**

## CHECK FOR GAS LEAKS

### **⚠ DANGER**

**Do not use an open flame to check for gas leaks. Be sure there are no sparks or open flames in the area while you check for leaks. Sparks or open flames will result in a fire or explosion, which can cause serious bodily injury or death and damage to property.**

You will need: a soap and water solution and a rag or brush to apply it.


- A) Mix soap and water.
- B) Turn on the gas supply at the source.
- C) Check for leaks by wetting the fitting with the soap and water solution and watching for bubbles. If bubbles form, or if a bubble grows, there is a leak.
- D) When leak checking is complete, turn gas supply off at the source and rinse connections with water.

#### **Check:**

- A) LP: Regulator connection (1).
- B) NG: Hose to quick disconnect gas line connection (2).

**⚠ DANGER: If there is a leak at connection (1 or 2), turn off the gas. DO NOT OPERATE THE GRILL. Failure to follow dangers, warnings and cautions contained in this Instruction sheet may cause a fire or an explosion resulting in serious personal injury or death as well as damage to property. When leak checks are complete, turn gas supply OFF at the source and rinse connections with water.
